agriculture with focus on soils. He is the author of more than 88 papers in peer review journals. Mr. Lugato is also leading the Carbon Removal on Land Project and worked on the SEPLA project "Satellite based mapping and monitoring of European peatland and wetland for LULUCF and agriculture".
